

ADMINISTRATION GOALS

The Albemarle County School Board (“School Board”) places the primary responsibility and authority for the administration of the School Division in the Superintendent. The Superintendent is responsible for the direction, leadership and coordination of students and staff in their efforts to reach educational goals adopted by the School Board.

The School Board expects the Superintendent to provide leadership in:

1. Decision-making.
2. Communication.
3. Planning, organizing, implementing, and evaluating educational programs;
4. Defining the School Division's organizational structure. All changes affecting principals and division-wide positions above the director level and all licensed personnel must be approved by the School Board. Approval of other personnel will be delegated to the Superintendent/designee.
5. Developing and maintaining close working relationships and channels of communication within the school system and community.
