SCOPE	This project would construct a standalone building that would house three bathrooms and a concession stand to be located near the girl's softball field at Western Albemarle High School. It will include all necessary utilities to support such a facility including a pump station. This portion of the project would also include a realigned and graded road area for ADA access. The project would also address miscellaneous ADA improvements needed elsewhere on campus including a ramp from the C wing to the bus loop and modifications to the stadium bleachers.
JUSTIFICATION	The restroom facility is in response to ongoing complaints and identified inequities between the baseball and softball facilities. The baseball field, located on the Henley Middle School campus, has adjacent restroom and locker room facilities. The facility was constructed in part due to a private donation. In contrast, the girl's softball field's closest restrooms are up at the football field or inside the school. Porta-johns are currently set up at the site. This is a potential Title IX violation as the facilities for girls and boys is not equitable.
	Various ADA improvements are required to ensure all students have equitable access to the experiences and opportunities. These particular improvements would allow a wheel-chair bound student to participate in the band program.
