

BOARD MEMBER AUTHORITY

The Albemarle County School Board is a corporate body and in its corporate capacity is vested with all the powers and charged with all the duties, obligations, and responsibilities imposed upon school boards by law. The Board may sue, be sued, contract, be contracted with, and purchase, take, hold, lease, and convey school property, both real and personal. School Board members shall have no authority or duties except such as may be assigned to them by the School Board as a whole.
