## LICENSED STAFF

The Virginia Board of Education shall, by regulation, prescribe the requirements for certification of teachers and other school personnel. No teacher is regularly employed by the School Board or paid from public funds unless such teacher holds a license or provisional license issued by the Virginia Board of Education or a local eligibility license issued by the School Board pursuant to Virginia Code §22.1-299.3.

- holds a license or provisional license issued by the Virginia Board of Education,
- holds a three-year license to teach high school career and technical education courses in specified subject areas, or
- is hired to teach in a trade and industrial education program and for whom the teacher licensure requirements have been waived by the Virginia Department of Education.

If a teacher employed under a provisional license is activated or deployed for military service within a school year (July 1 – June 30), an additional year will be added to the teacher's provisional license for each school year or portion thereof the teacher is activated or deployed. The additional year or years shall be granted the following year or years after the return of the teacher from deployment or activation.–

<u>The Virginia Board of Education prescribes, by regulation, the requirements for the licensure for teachers and other school personnel required to hold a license.</u> Requirements for teaching and other licenses are stated in the Licensure Regulations for School Personnel adopted by the Board of Education.
