
































Division Pass Rates Compared to 2018-2019

The table below shows division unadjusted and growth adjusted pass rates in English and Math for the 2021-2022 school year and the 2018-2019 school year. The 2018-2019 school year was the most recent year that all students took SOL tests before the pandemic impacted schools and testing.

Please note that the state does not calculate growth adjusted pass rates at the school division level. These calculations are compiled by ACPs staff based on the published results of all of our individual schools.
