SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The School Board of Albemarle County, <u>Virginia</u>, <u>("School Board")</u> derives its authority from the Constitution <u>and laws of Virginia</u>, <u>of Virginia</u>, the <u>Code of Virginia</u>, and the regulations of the State Board of Education.

The Albemarle County-School Board members are officers of the Commonwealth.

The Albemarle County School Board governs the school division.

The School Board is a corporate body whose official title is "The School Board of Albemarle County, Virginia"."
