Policy FA

II. NAMING OF NEW SCHOOLS

General Provisions

The School Board reserves the sole control and authority over the naming of any school and the right to rename a school at any time if the name is deemed by the School Board to be inconsistent with the current vision, mission, goals and values of the School Board. It is the intent of the School Board to involve students, teachers and interested citizens that reflect the diversity of the Division's community in the process of naming schools.

The Board shall name schools in recognition of:

- The geographic area in which the school is located.
- Any entity, quality, or ideal, the School Board deems worthy of recognition.

Geographic Features

Lambs Lane is located within the **Piedmont region**, a broad area of rolling hills and valleys between the coastal plain and the Blue Ridge Mountains. The geographic features are primarily related to the surrounding urban area of Charlottesville, including the Rivanna River, the Southwest Mountains, and the Blue Ridge Mountains. The Rivanna River, a tributary of the James River, runs near Charlottesville, which is located just west of the Southwest Mountains. Ivy Creek Natural Area is a 219-acre preserve with a diverse range of geographical features, including upland woods, pine stands, open fields, streams, and two miles of shoreline. It's located on the South Fork Rivanna Reservoir and is shadowed by the Blue Ridge Mountains.






Comments
